INTRODUCTION

The OLITREVA project was developed within the European Seventh Framework Programme of the European Commission to reinforce scientific and technological (S&T) capacities of the Palestinian research institution working in the field of Olive Mill Waste Treatment and Valorisation by increasing networking and cooperation with European centres of scientific excellence. The organisation of an International Conference in Palestine at the end of the OLITREVA project is one of the main objectives of Workpackage 5: Dissemination and Networking. The aim of the conference is not only to disseminate project results, but also to exchange ideas and present the latest research works in the field of Olive Mill Waste Treatment and Valorisation. Therefore it is addressed to researchers, olive-oil associations, governmental authorities, end users and any other specialists in the sector.

OLITREVA INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE TOPICS

The OLITREVA International Conference aims at the participation of researchers of the Mediterranean Partner Countries of the OLITREVA project, in order to disseminate their work in the international scenario. Specialised seminars will be given by the members of the project's consortium to present the results obtained throughout the project. The covered topics are:

- Olive mill waste (OMW) production and characterization;
- Environmental impacts of OMW;
- Potential and technologies for valorisation of residues from olive oil production;
- Potential for joint research, international cooperation and know-how transference activities.

Researchers interested to participate in the OLITREVA conference are invited to submit abstracts for oral presentation, as well as abstracts for posters. Abstracts will be reviewed and evaluated by the scientific committee. Submissions should include title, author affiliation(s), contact details and an abstract of up to 300 words, giving an overview of: context, methodology, results and recommendation.
